



### Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections





### **Aadhar Coverage across Prevailing Caste Sections**





### **Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section**





#### **Government Schemes Coverage**




Percentage of Households





#### Households with and without toilets across different prevailing caste section in village




#### Use of toilets across different prevailing caste section in village












### Source Wise Irrigation Coverage among then households




### Irrigation methods used among the households






#### Cattle wise population per household among various







Lighting Source and usage in Village






